1. Who We Are

We do not collect sensitive personal data (e.g., health, biometric, or racial/ethnic data).



3. How We Use Your Information

We use your data only where the law allows. The main purposes are:

- Responding to enquiries you submit (Legitimate interest)

- Improving our website and services (Legitimate interest)

- Sending updates if you register interest (Consent)

You can ask us to delete your data at any time.

- Complying with legal duties (Legal obligation)		
4. Who We Share It With		
We only share your data where necessary, including:		
- Formspree - to handle contact form submissions		
- Email and web hosting providers - for secure data transmission and storage		
- Legal or regulatory authorities - if required to comply with the law		
We do not sell your personal data or share it with advertisers.		
5. How Long We Keep It		
- Contact form enquiries: normally 12 months		
- Marketing opt-ins: until you withdraw consent		
- Technical/cookie data: see Cookie Policy for details		



6. Your	Riahts
